## **CCP Implementation Cycle**

We are currently in our second CCP Implementation Cycle! This cycle will capture the CCP data from February 19<sup>th</sup> thru March 20<sup>th</sup>. Please see the specific asks of the team below:

- Choose one of the tools below to track assignment of a CCP category:
  - REDCap survey
  - Excel spreadsheet
- To build CCP category assignment into your notes, consider creating an EPIC SmartPhrase to support the documentation of CCP assignments in your POD0/1 note template. A sample SmartPhrase and instructions are attached (feel free to tailor them to your needs).
- For all liver transplants performed between 2/19/26 and 3/20/26 at your center, please use your selected tool to document whether the assignment of CCP categories (intended immunosuppression dosing) occurred within 48 hours of transplant and what those categories were
- Anyone on your team may enter the information—for example, you may share the REDCap link with the on-service attending or have the fellow insert the SmartPhrase into their note for later review by an OPTIMAL team member—as long as the intended dosing is documented within 48 hours.
- At the end of Cycle 2, we will send a summary survey asking about how the implementation went—wins, challenges, strategies to share.
